Aunt Flow products are made with organic cotton (no weird stuff) and we are constantly working to reduce our environmental impact.”

Why Aunt Flow?

Free-vend dispensers:

Our period product dispenser is free-vend, so no one has to use a quarter to get a product out of the machine.

Give-back program:

For every 10 period products sold, we donate 1 back to a menstruator in need.



Easy to refill:

Aunt Flow dispensers include a window to see when the product is running low.

Sustainable:

We launched a new design for our menstrual pads to cut down on plastic. Plus, all period products are made with organic cotton.

High capacity:

Our period product dispenser holds up to 5x the capacity compared to other brands.
